Data Notes

Data is reported at the wildlife management unit scale where possible. In some units it is not possible to compare 2019 hunters to 2021 proposed tags due to proposed controlled hunt boundaries splitting wildlife management units and/or including multiple units.

Data includes all archery elk hunts and hunters in eastern Oregon

General season hunters are assigned to a wildlife management unit using mandatory reporting data on which unit they hunted the most

"Hunters" is the number of actual hunters (not drawn tags or sold tags)

"Proposed 2021 Archery Tags" includes all proposed (new and existing) archery elk hunts in Eastern Oregon

"Total Archery Hunters 2019" includes all eastern Oregon general and controlled archery elk hunters

"General Season Tag Hunters 2019" only includes hunters that held a General Archery Elk Tag (i.e. excludes controlled hunt tags)

"Non-resident Hunters over 5% 2019" is the number of non-resident hunters in 2019 that would have exceeded a 5% cap if a controlled hunt was adopted instead of a general season.
