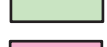
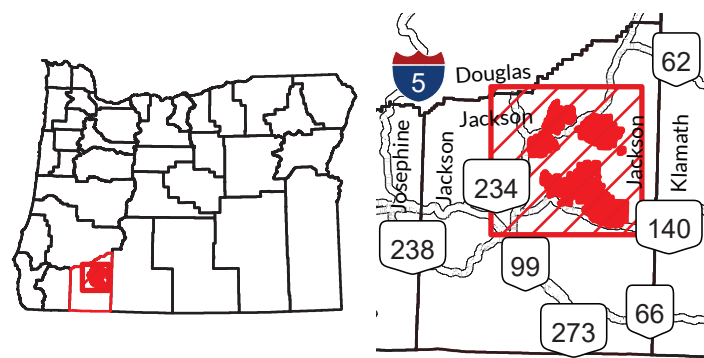

Year Round Access
Period of Vehicle Restriction:
Oct. 15 - April 30

Hunting on private lands is a privilege, not a right. A majority of the public BLM lands within these boundaries of this travel management area are classified as O&C Timberlands, with many of the roads leading to these public lands being privately owned and maintained. Thus landowners have the right to restrict vehicle access which can affect access to public lands. Private land hunting opportunities will remain in the future only if the property and rights of private landowners are respected! Abuse it and you will lose it! Don't be the reason another gate is put in that ruins public hunting access for all!

- Area Regulations:**
- Motorized vehicle travel restricted to green dot roads during the vehicle restriction period and prohibited at all times on red dot roads.
 - Motorized vehicle travel within the TMA boundary on all other unimproved roads, trails, and cross-country is prohibited except by landowners and their employees/agents, or cooperating agencies and their staff/agents.
 - Vehicle restrictions implemented during Upper Rogue TMA timeframe (General West Cascade Elk season) will take precedence over Jackson TMA on USFS roads that overlap.
 - Do not block gates or access through green dot roads
 - Walk-in and motor-less bike-in access will be allowed on all roads.
 - No parking over 300-feet from open roads within the TMA boundary.
 - Camping on private lands is prohibited.
 - *No fires on private lands at any time. Be mindful of any item or activity that could produce a spark. (including dragging trailer chains, parking or driving on dry grass, or cigarettes).
 - No littering or dumping, pick up any trash.
 - Respect landowners' rights and needs.
 - Report unlawful activities.
 - Private Lands reserve the right to restrict public access during logging activities and at certain specified Industrial Fire Precaution Levels (IFPL).
 - IFPL level 1 all private lands are walk-in only access, except Silver Butte (closed).
 - IFPL level 2-4 all private lands are closed to any access (foot or vehicle).

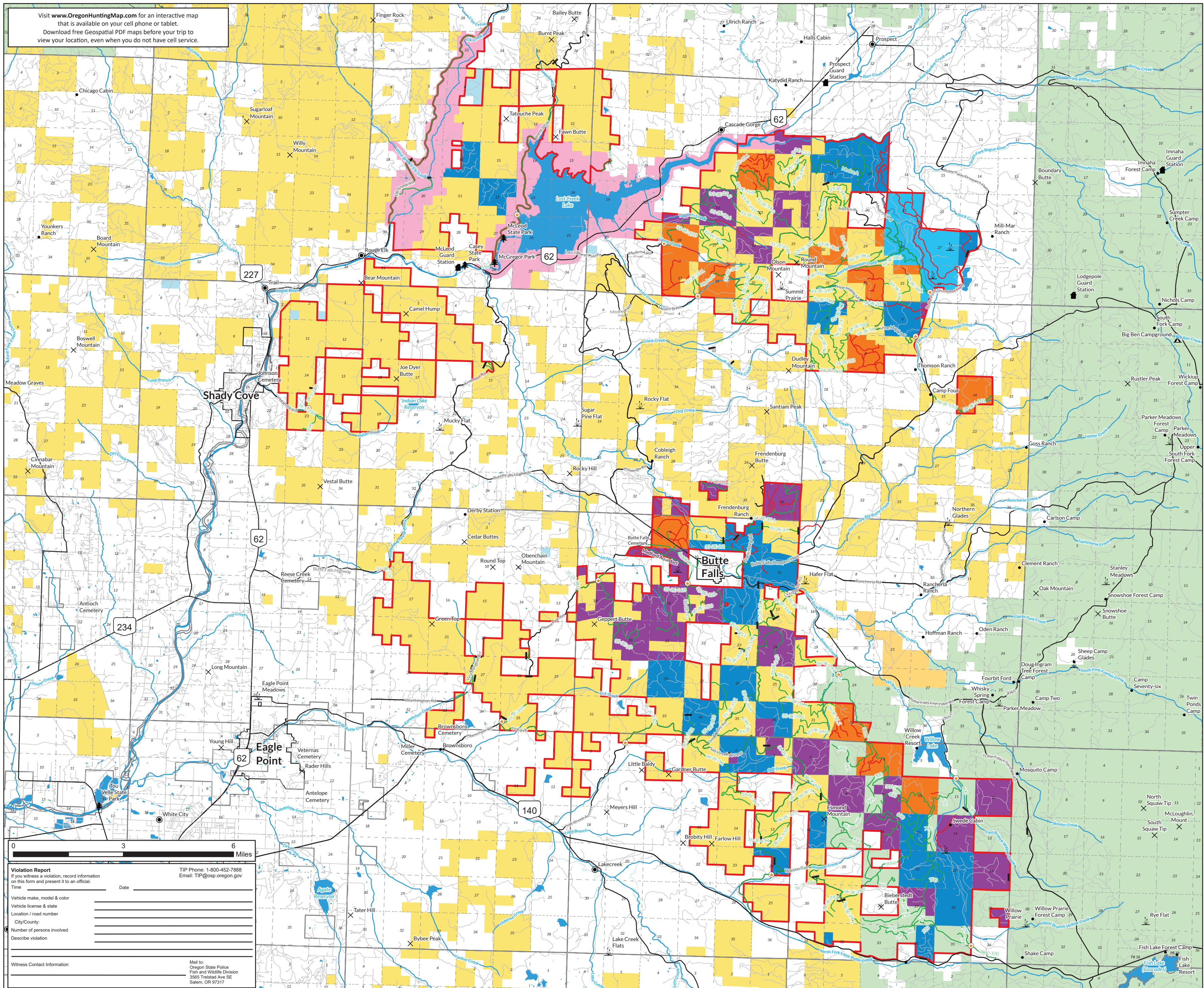
