3 days prior to the opening of archery season through close of all bull elk rifle seasons. Access may be closed due to fire danger or for management reasons.

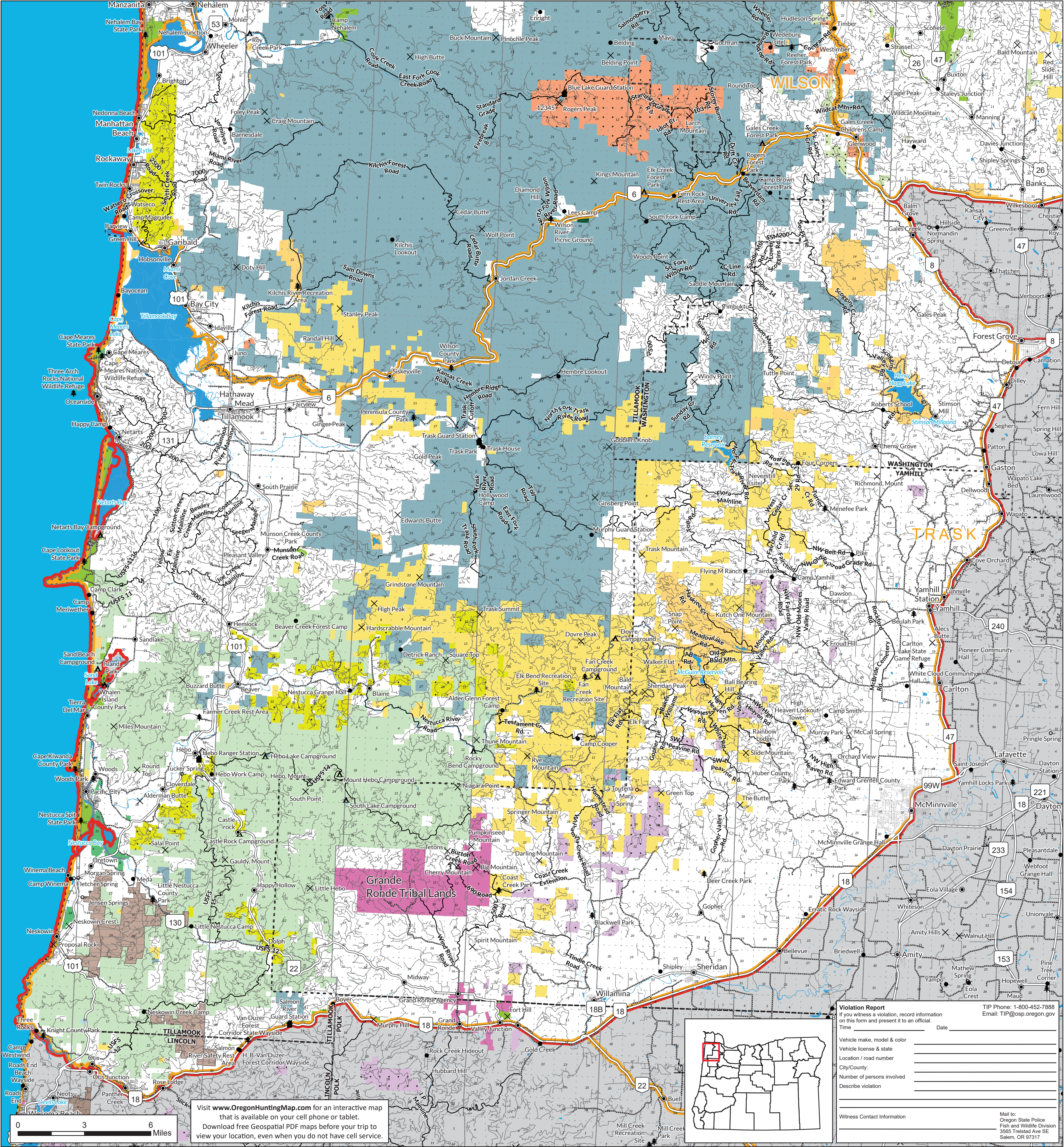
The North Coast TMA is a cooperative access program with several public and private landowners. The program helps control wildlife damage and maintains public hunting access on private and surrounding public land. The TMA provides public hunting opportunity for deer, elk, bear, cougar, grouse, and quail. All Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife Regulations and Seasons apply. Area may be closed during high fire danger. Land-owner designations on the map may vary in accuracy due to frequent land exchanges. Many of the roads that are closed to motor vehicles by gates, posted signs or barriers are open for walk-in hunting only. Please contact individual landowners about their access policy and current closures.
