Consider simplified rule language that implements increases to commercial fishery fees adopted by the Oregon Legislature via House Bill 2342.





Legislative Action

2025 Oregon Legislature increased most commercial license, permit, and ad valorem fees, as requested by ODFW.

- Commercial Fish Fund
- Supports fishery and program management, research, and monitoring
- Removed the Albacore Landing License





New Fees: 12%-4%-4%



License and Permits

Removed most "Permit Fee" rules

Referenced ORS in "Renewal" rule

Exceptions: shellfish/intertidal and albacore tuna

Pink Shrimp Permit Fee (Repeal)

[(1) The annual fee for a Pink Shrimp Permit is \$200.00 (plus a \$2.00 license agent fee) for resident applicants and \$250.00 (plus a \$2.00 license agent fee) for non-resident applicants. See ORS 508.901.

(2) A fee of \$100.00 shall be charged for each transfer of participation rights under OAR 635-005-0615. See ORS 508.907.

Renewal of Pink Shrimp Permit

Pink Shrimp Permits may be renewed the following year [by submitting to the Department a \$200.00 fee (plus a \$2.00 license agent fee) for resident applicants and \$250.00 fee (plus a \$2.00 license agent fee) for non-resident applicants and a complete application date stamped or postmarked by December 31 of the year the permit is sought for renewal.]pursuant to ORS 508.892 and ORS 508.901.
