# Northeast A&H Region



## Columbia Plateau Habitat Initiative

Ensures CRP mid-management work will benefit wildlife on **5,000** acres

Incentivizes landowners to provide public access



## Heppner Regulated Hunt Area

Provided public access for over 58 years

Welcome to Hunt access to **13,429** acres



## Manulife Access Area NE

Provides a minimum of **250,000** acres of access

Road management provides refuges for deer and elk

Limits crowding in WMUs with limited public land



# Southwest A&H Region




## Crestmont Habitat and Hunt

Provides By Permission hunting access via the Hunt By Reservation system

Conducts ~45 acres of habitat work to develop more early seral stage forested habitats

Creates more **wildfire and drought resistant** timber stands
