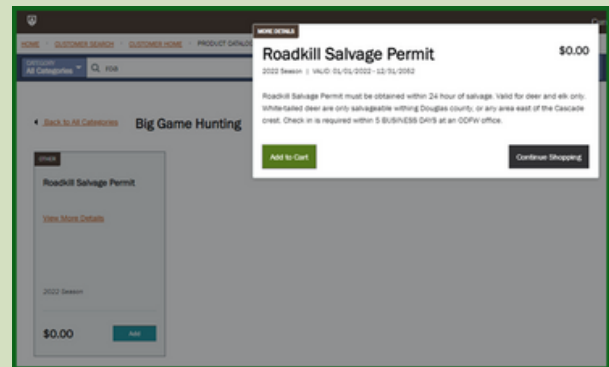
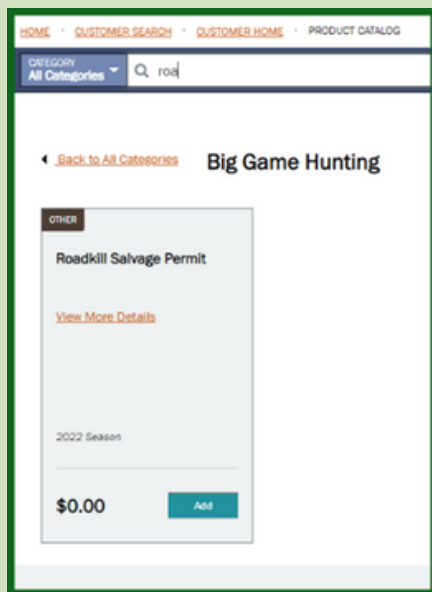


# How to apply for a free ODFW roadkill salvage permit

Step #1: Already have an ODFW account? Login at ODFW's licensing page and select roadkill salvage permit from product catalog

Antlers and head of all salvaged animals need to be surrendered to an ODFW field office within 5 business days of taking possession of the carcass: **CALL AHEAD TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT** (Tissue samples from the head will be tested as part of the state's surveillance program for Chronic Wasting Disease). Other animal parts, such as the hide, may be kept by the permittee.

**Bring this permit to the check in appointment. Meat from the animal must be stored with the ODFW ID# and Confirmation Number or this permit attached to the packaging.**

*This Roadkill Salvage Permit allows a person to recover, possess, transport, and use the carcass of a deer or elk killed as a result of an accidental collision with a vehicle for the purpose of salvaging the meat for human consumption. All of the specific conditions and requirements for the Roadkill Salvage Permit program are available online at myodfw.com.*

**Don't forget to surrender head and antlers to ODFW office within 5 days of salvage!**
