The opening of Western Cascade General Buck Deer Season until the close of the Western Oregon General Elk Season for WMUs 19 and 21.
1 hour before sunrise to 1 hour after sunset.
Access may be closed due to fire

Only roads shown in green on this map or posted with an orange road marker in the field are open to motor vehicles during the period of restriction. Some areas may be closed to all access due to fire danger, or to certain types of traffic.

- Only roads shown in green on this map or posted with an orange road marker in the field are open to motor vehicle travel. All other motor vehicle travel is prohibited.

There will generally be no posting of closed roads except temporary closures of roads due to management actions

- Vehicle access is allowed through designated gates as identified on this map. Any other gates into the area will remain closed.
- The area is open from 1 hour before sunrise to 1 hour

after sunset unless designated as closed or otherwise by signs in the field.

- Bay use only, no camping or fires.
- No motorcycles or ATVs allowed.
- Any vehicle blocking any road is prohibited and may be towed at the owner's expense.

- Target shooting is prohibited.
- Guiding is prohibited.

- Removal of forest products is prohibited.
- Respect landowners rights and needs.
- Thermal and infrared devices are prohibited on the

Thermal and infrared devices are prohibited on the property. If caught in possession of thermal or infrared devices, the owner and all passengers will be banned from visiting properties for life.
