Ceremonial Tags Annually since 2017

- 2020 Increase Elk Tags
- 2022 Malheur NWR with Refuge Permit

Memorandum of Agreement 2022

- Shared goals for Fish and Wildlife Management
- Memorialized Commitment to the Hunt Program



ISSUE: Update Ceremonial and Subsistence Tags for Burn Paiute Tribe

- Transition Mule Deer Hunt Areas from WMU to DHA
- Modify Hunt Area for Elk and Pronghorn
- Increase Mule Deer tags to 16 and 30 for Elk
- Adds Subsistence as a Recognized Purpose
