

- Over 601,000 acres of recreational access
- Highly utilized TMA
- Salmon returning to the Klamath Basin viewing opportunity
- OSP enforcement project

Bear Creek Access Area

- 10,029 acres of access
- Weed control, forest mgt. and fence removal




Iron Mountain Access Area

- 4,215 acres of landlocked BLM
- Access in the Lookout Mtn. WMU



Virtue Flat Access Area

- Interspersed with 10,848 acres of BLM
- Habitat work for sage grouse



Malheur A&H Projects




Pine Creek Access Area

- Welcome to Hunt access to 12,104 acres of private land.
- Improves access to surrounding public lands



Mackenzie Access Area

- Provides access to 11,029 acres of private land.
- Recent habitat work includes annual grass treatments benefiting sage grouse and water improvements



Northwest A&H Projects




Upper Molalla Meadows Restoration

- Maintains open meadows/early seral stage habitat
- Keep wildlife on public land decreasing damage on private forestlands



Thomas Creek Access Area

- Opens 47,694 acres of hunter access
- Only closed during IFPL 4

A&H Insurance Payments

- \$100 payment for time spent consulting with insurance
- Cover costs of:
 - Adding department as additionally insured
 - Liability insurance if needed
