The National Wild Turkey Federation (NWTF) is a conservation organization whose mission is to conserve wild turkey populations and ensure healthy, resilient habitats for wild turkeys and other forest-dependent species while preserving our hunting heritage. NWTF is a national organization with approximately 250,000 members nationwide, including a state chapter and several local chapters in Oregon. NWTF recently reviewed the Upland Game Bird Regulation Proposals for the 2026–27 seasons.
