Comment:

The proposed sport regs for the central coast halibut are very liberal both as to open dates and a 2 fish limit. I believe the primary objective should be to provide for opportunities to harvest at least one halibut from May 1 into September. To accomplish this the limit should be reduced to 1 fish if needed mid season to make sure the spring season lasts until end of July. Additionally the spring season should be closed if the quota for that season is reached even after the reduction to 1 fish. The spring season should not be allowed to reduce the summer season opportunity. These additional measures will benefit Oregon residents who enjoy a full season opportunity. Consideration should also be considered to increase the annual limit to 9 fish. This would also benefit local residents
