Congratulations, you have been successful in the Big Game Controlled Hunt Drawing. Please refer to the 2025 Big Game Hunting Regulations to determine your hunt dates and area.

Now that you have drawn your tag, you will require some special information which is specific to your tag/hunt before you go hunting in the 2025 season.

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND REMINDERS

Congratulations! You have been successful in drawing a **275T INTERSTATE-SILVER LAKE YOUTH CONTROLLED HUNT** tag. Check your tag for the hunt dates and bag limit authorized. This antlerless elk hunt has been designed to give young hunters a chance to develop proper hunting skills and ethics while hunting on public and private lands. We hope you are as excited about this hunting opportunity as we are in offering it to you. The future of youth hunts and the potential for the program to expand depends on the ethics, safety, and conduct of the participants.

The hunt area includes all of the Silver Lake Unit and all of the Interstate Unit. See the 2025 big game regulations for the specific hunt area description. **A portion of your hunt area will be closed to motor vehicle access at different times during the hunt period.**

Cabin Lake/Silver Lake Cooperative Winter Range Closure: December 1, 2025 – March 31, 2026

While portions of this area are closed to motorized vehicles, non-motorized access is allowed on public lands, and on private lands on which one has permission to access.
