Controlled Hunts

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Congratulations, you have been successful in the Big Game Controlled Hunt Drawing. Please refer to the 2026 Big Game Hunting Regulations to determine your hunt dates and area.

Now that you have drawn your tag, you are required to review some special information which is specific to your tag/hunt before you go hunting in the 2026 season.

SPECIAL INFORMATION AND REMINDERS

Please carefully review the 2026 rules page below for hunt area rules and further information regarding The Dalles Watershed Archery Elk Hunt (241R). Hunters must sign the attached compliance agreement and obtain an entry permit prior to the hunt. Hunters must contact the Mid-Columbia Field Office to set up a check-in date and time before the hunt begins. See office contact information below.

CITY OF THE DALLES WATERSHED MANAGEMENT COMPLIANCE CRITERIA FOR 241R Controlled ELK HUNT

The Dalles Municipal Watershed is **closed to unauthorized entry** to protect the quality of the domestic water supply for the citizens of The Dalles, Oregon. Certain types of resource activities which are compatible with the objectives of maintaining water quality and quantity are permitted to occur on a limited and controlled basis including controlled elk hunts. Persons found in violation of the "Watershed Reserve Closure Ordinance" are cited into the appropriate jurisdiction for prosecution. Users of the Watershed must obtain authorization to enter the closed area by issuance of a "Watershed Entry Permit" defining the terms of permitted access; entry permits for Watershed elk hunts are issued at the initial check in. Once in possession of a legal permit for entry, the user will be expected to cooperate and obey all rules and regulations. **Failure to comply will result in termination of the permit and possible citing for violations.**

1. SMOKING IS PROHIBITED.
2. NO FIRES OF ANY KIND ARE PERMITTED.
3. DISCHARGE OF HUMAN FECAL WASTE IS PROHIBITED except in provided toilet facilities. In an emergency use the 6 - 8 inch burial technique at least 500 feet from any stream, wet area, or draw.
4. NO LITTERING OR DEPOSIT OF MATERIAL WASTES OR GARBAGE IS ALLOWED. Carry in - carry out.
5. NO BODY CONTACT ACTIVITY WITH STREAMS, SPRINGS, OR LAKES IS PERMITTED.
6. NO OVERNIGHT STAY IS PERMITTED within the Reserve.
7. NO MOTORIZED EQUIPMENT OR VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE RESERVE. Administrative and other permitted vehicle traffic is likely to occur in the hunt area during the controlled elk hunts; information on known traffic areas will be available at the time of hunter check-in.
8. NO PACK OR RIDING ANIMALS OR MOUNTAIN BIKES WILL BE PERMITTED; your hunting experience will be one of walking.
9. NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY TYPE ARE PERMITTED within the Reserve.

SPECIAL PERMIT HUNT REGULATIONS:

11. CHECK-IN: Hunters are required to register prior to entering the Watershed. Please contact The Dalles ODFW District Office at 541-296-8026 to make arrangements for check in prior to the hunt beginning.
12. CHECK-OUT: Hunters are required to exit the Watershed daily. Upon conclusion of your hunt a self-service kiosk will be at the check station location to deposit your entry permit.
12. Permits to enter the Watershed will be issued to the tagholder with a valid 241R Controlled Hunt Tag. One additional person may accompany the tagholder in the watershed during the hunt. This individual is not allowed to hunt and must remain in the immediate vicinity of the permittee at all times.
13. Tagholder WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE THE PERMIT IN THEIR POSSESSION WHILE IN THE WATERSHED.
14. Hunting of bear or cougar using archery equipment is allowed for hunters with a VALID, UNUSED 241R controlled elk tag.
15. After harvesting an animal, it shall be removed by the end of the following day. Once hunters have retrieved their elk, they may not enter the Watershed unless accompanying another tagholder with an unfilled 241R tag.
16. A five-dollar per hunter fee will be paid to the City to help offset the costs of administering the hunt. Bring \$5.00 cash to your check-in appointment.
