Congratulations, you have been successful for the **Swan Lake Youth Pronghorn hunt (432T)**. Please refer to the Big Game Hunting Regulations to determine your hunt dates and area.

Now that you have drawn your tag, you will require some special information which is specific to your tag/hunt before you go hunting in this season.

- This opportunity for this hunt is only made available by generous landowner willingness to open up portions of their lands for you.
- You **MUST** obtain permission from any private landowners before hunting. Close cooperation between hunters and landowners is necessary for a successful hunting season.
- Please be respectful to the landowners property during your hunt.
 - Do not drive anywhere you are not given permission to.
 - Respect neighboring property boundaries.
 - Remember to leave all gates as you found them.
- Be aware of high fire potential. For information on current fire danger and restrictions, see the Department of Forestry's web site at www.odf.state.or.us, or call any local office of the US Forest Service or Bureau of Land Management.
- Be respectful to the other hunters that may be within the hunt area.

ADULT: This controlled hunt is part of a program to encourage youth participation in big game hunting. To participate in this hunt the Youth Hunter must be accompanied by an adult 21 years of age or older. The adult accompanying the youth does not need a hunting license. Please set a good example for these new hunters.
