To enable your free disabled veteran combination - hunting, angling and shellfish license, complete this application and return it with a copy of your letter from the U.S. Veterans Administration, or any branch of the Armed Forces of the United States, showing an **overall disability rating** of at least **25 percent**. Once enabled, license is renewable every year online or at any licensing agent. The VA certification may be obtained by calling 1-800-827-1000.
