

Columbia Area –

Waterfowl – Most of the waterfowl can be found in or along the Columbia River. There are private ponds that hold a variety of waterfowl in near Tygh Valley, Dufur, and Grass Valley but permission would need to be obtained. Hunting waterfowl along the Columbia can be very productive but check the weather as the conditions can be dangerous for boaters during the season. State parks have specific areas along the Columbia that are open to hunting; check the state parks web page to see what areas may be closed to hunters found [here](#).

Many waterfowl species will use the Columbia, typically Wigeon and Mallards and the divers are most abundant, but Canvasbacks and Eurasian Wigeon can be found here as well.
